

CHARGING THE BATTERY

Before first use, it is recommended you charge your headphones for a minimum of 1 hour

- 1. Insert the small end of the included USB-C cable into the USB-C connector on the headphone's right ear pad
- 2. Connect the other end of the charging cable to a USB port on your PC, laptop, wall outlet adapter or other charging device
- 3. The LED light will show a solid red colour to indicate charging is
- 4. The light will turn white when fully charged

- Charge only with 5V DC 500mA input
- Use only the original USB-C charging cable to avoid any damage
- When the LED flashes red, the battery is low, charge the headphones

POWER ON/OFF

- 1. Press and hold the multi-function button for two seconds
- 2. When powered on successfully the headphones will sound a tone and the power light will turn on
- 3. To power off the headphones press and hold the multifunction button for four seconds
- 4. The headphones will sound a tone and the light will turn off




PAIRING

- 1. With your headphones powered on the indicator light will flash red and white to show your headphones are in pairing mode. If you are already connected to a device turn your headphones off first then hold the multi-function button down for 4 seconds to turn on and enter pairing mode again
- 2. Enable Bluetooth on your device, search for and select CE220647 from the list to connect.
- 3. When the headphones are successfully paired with your device, you will hear a single alert tone and the LED will flash white every 10 seconds to indicate your headphones are powered on and paired successfully.





- 1. To reset to factory settings power on the headset
- 2. Press and hold both volume + and for 10s or until LED blinks red 5 times to reset it to factory settings. It will automatically go into pairing mode.



- Connected: LED blinks white every 10s
- 2. BASS mode: LED glows solid white
- 3. Charging: LED glows solid red
- 4. Fully charged: LED glows solid white
- 5. Low battery: LED flashes red

LISTENING TO YOUR DEVICE

Once you have successfully paired to a device, you can play, pause, track forward, track backward and change the volume using the headphone controls/device controls

USING THE AUDIO CABLE

The included audio cable can be used to connect to a non-wireless device or for listening to music when the headphone batteries have been drained

- 1. Connect the included 3.5mm audio cable to the aux-in iack located on the right earcup
- 2. Connect the other end of the audio cable to the audio jack

NOTE: When connected via audio cable, the Bluetooth function and controls are disabled. You cannot control playback using the headphone controls when connected via aux-in. The headphones will not be discoverable on Bluetooth

BATTERY CARE

- Make sure that your headphones are switched OFF after use
- Do not leave a fully charged battery connected to a charger, since overcharging may shorten its lifetime
- Before storing the headphones for long periods of time, be sure to fully charge the battery
- When the battery is low and flashing red you must charge the headphones
- If the battery is completely discharged, the headphones cannot be turned on immediately when the charger is connected. Allow a depleted battery to charge for a few minutes before turning on the headphones
- Always try to keep the battery between 15°C and 30°C. A product with a hot or cold battery may not work temporarily, even when the battery is fully charged

MULTI-CONNECTION MODE (Max 2 devices)

Multi-connection mode allows the headphones to pair to two Bluetooth devices simultaneously. This feature enables users to receive calls or notifications from one device while using audio from another, enhancing overall user experience and flexibility.

- 1. Enable Bluetooth on your first device and connect the headphones
- 2. Turn off the bluetooth from your device. The headphones will now be in pairing mode
- 3. Enable Bluetooth on your second device and connect the headphones
- 4. Enable Bluetooth on your first device again and connect it to the headphones NOTE: Only one device will be able to provide the
